

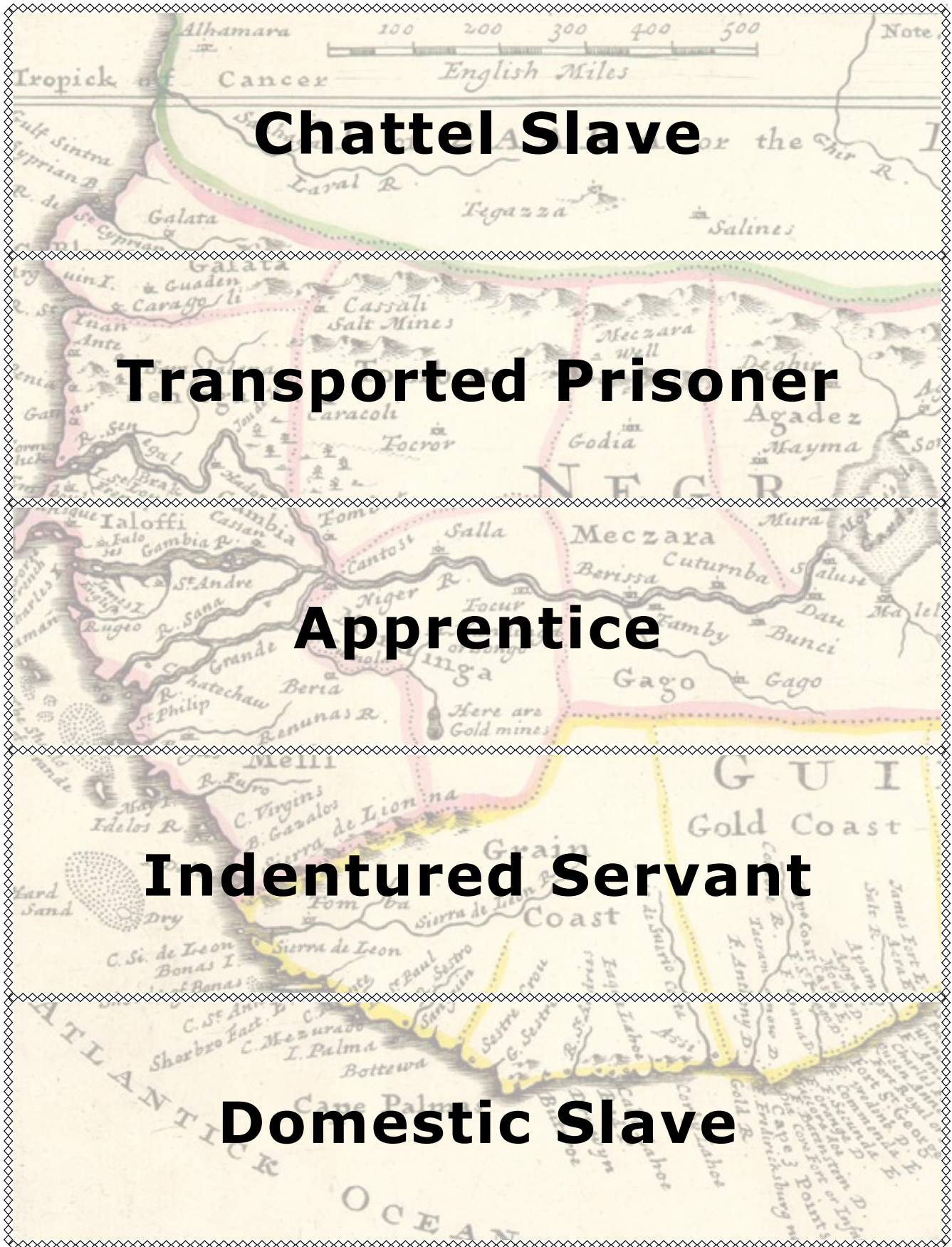
'Different Types of Slavery' Discussion Cards


To be cut out and used as part of the lesson 'What is Slavery?'



I took part in a rebellion and I could have been put to death, but instead I was sentenced to work on a plantation for 14 years.

I am 14 years of age. My parents bound me to a master for 7 years and I must do chores and learn a trade. If I run away my master has a legal right to get me back.

I was born in Liverpool but I could not get work. So instead I sold my labour for seven years in return for a free passage to Virginia and my keep. After the seven years I hope to be able to work for myself.

I was kidnapped and sold to slave traders, I am the legal property of my owner and he may choose what he uses me for. My children can be sold and they are also the property of my owner.

I live within a household and I must do as the head of the household tells me. I have lost everything, my home, family and place in society.
